



2022-23 NISCA National Dual Meet Team Ranking

Sponsored by IST – International Sports Timing

We would like to thank all the teams who participated in the 2022-2023 National Dual Meet Team Ranking program. In total, 186 teams participated this year, down from 239 teams in 2021-2022. On the pages that follow, you will see the 2022 – 2023 final rankings by class, and a Summary of Data page. Some notes about this year's results:

- This year we had 82 girls' entries (down from 103 a year ago) and 104 boys' entries (down from 136 a year ago)
- 29 states are represented, down from 32 last year
- Two states entered 15 or more teams –Michigan (28), and North Carolina (15)
- Three schools were repeat champs: Brookfield East HS, WI (Class 6 – three straight), Upper Arlington, OH (Class 7 – three straight), Santa Margarita Catholic HS, CA (Class 12 - three straight)
- One school was a double-winner – Upper Arlington (OH, Class 7) (top ranking for boys and girls in their respective class)
- Santa Margarita Catholic HS (CA) had the top overall girls' entry, with 6,634 points, while Hinsdale Central was top amongst all boys' entries, with 6,559 points
- Sixteen (16) teams were over 6,000 points (up from 14 last year) and 78 schools had 5,000 or more (91 achieved that total in the 2020-2021 competition)
- In the combined girl/boy ranking, Santa Margarita Catholic HS (12,962 points) finished first, overall
- By enrollment, the top boy/girl combos included Weston HS (MA, Classes 1/5, 8,974 combined points), Grosse Pointe South HS (MI, Classes 2/6, 10,278 points), Upper Arlington HS (OH, Classes 3/7, 11,647 points), The Woodlands (TX, Classes 4/8, 12,446 points), The Westminster Schools (GA, Classes 9/11, 8,444 points), and Santa Margarita Catholic High School (CA, Classes 10/12, 12,962 points).
