

Proposal for By-Law Amendment, 2024

Proposed Amendment to By-Laws:

Current By-Law:

Article V - Nominations and Elections, Voting Procedures

SECTION 2 Voting procedures for officers:

d. There shall be a secret written ballot taken, and an election committee of three (3), appointed by the President, shall count the votes.

Proposed Change:

d. If there is a single nominee for any office, that officer may be accepted by acclamation. If there is more than one nominee on the ballot, there shall be a secret written ballot taken, and an election committee of three (3), appointed by the President, shall count the votes.

Rationale:

If there is only a single nominee for a position, there is no point in going through the process of voting with a paper ballot. This will save time and paper on elections.
